You are requested to enter a minimum of one class in advance of the show and send all horse, rider and owner papers/cards with that entry to allow us to enter details of horse and rider in the computer. Even if only shipping in for the day please let us know you are coming.

Stabling needs to be booked to guarantee a stable, after that you need to check for availability. Stables are available **from 12 noon wednesday** including initial bale of bedding. If you require additional bedding please bring your own or purchase from the facility.

Day stables are subject to availability.

Stabling ONLY online bookings! PLEASE BOOK EARLY TO ENSURE AVAILABILITY and book before the, no stabling will be allocated without payment. One bale of shavings will be provided as bedding, extra shavings can be purchased on the showground. No straw is allowed. **A surcharge will be applied of stables are not mucked out before leaving.** Hay and haylage will be available to buy on site. Day stables may be available subject to numbers.

Electricity Points -Limited points are available, they will be issued on a first paid first issued basis.

Dogs are welcome on the showground but must be kept on a lead and are not allowed in the café.

Owners must clean up after dogs and horses and muck out stables before leaving.

Oakridge can provide a muck-out service if required, please see secretary. A muck-out fee will be applied to stables not cleaned out.

Refunds -Any fees refunded will have 10% deducted for administration costs.

Any fees show or cafeteria tabs not settled by the end of the show will be subject to a 25% surcharge.

Patterns -All patterns will be posted on the website in advance. **Please be sure to bring printed copies with you.**

Please assist the smooth running of the show by ensuring that copies of relevant registration documents and exhibitor's member cards are given to the Secretary in advance of the Show. You are requested to enter a minimum of one class in advance and send all required paperwork with that entry.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE YOUR HORSE'S VACCINATION RECORDS AND PASSPORTS AT THE SHOW.

AQHA -Exhibitors must have a current membership covering the division being entered. If your AQHA Membership is due to run out near to the show please ensure that you renew in time to receive your membership card otherwise renew at the Show.

***AQHA L1 classes** regardless of Open/Amateur or Youth will allow for any horse of any age to be shown one or two handed with a snaffle bit/ hackamore.

L 1 exhibitors may participate on a non-owned horse I L 1 classes only at aqha-approved shows without the use of permits.

L 1 points will be established every year for each class. L 1 eligibility point cap will be greater of 25 points and it is the exhibitor's points in youth and amateur and the horse in open classes.

The Secretary MUST have sight of your current AQHA Card or must issue a temporary one when renewing. AQHA website www.aqha.com

NRHA Classes -Exhibitors and owners must be current members of NRHA and horses must have an NRHA Competition license. Open riders showing in Open classes are required to have a Professional membership. Anyone showing in Rookie or Non Pro Classes must have a Non Pro Card. NRHA website www.nrha.com

NRHA Green Reiner and Ride & Slide classes: Open to competitors with 0-500 dollar in earnings. Only requires a associate membership for riders. No horse license or membership for owner.

May be ridden two handed in a bit or a snaffle regardless of horse age. You can go back and forth between one hand on the reins to two without penalties. You can also borrow a horse and show and simple lead changes is allowed without penalties.

British Reining -Classes -All Owners and Exhibitors must produce a current BR membership card and all horses must produce either a BR or NRHA Competition Licence. www.BritishReining.co.uk

Please Note: Allbreed / Oak Unaffiliated Classes, Western tack only in western classes. Except in Oak Any rider/ any horse/any tack reiningclasses.

Small Fry -Open to any child that has not earned any points in AQHA classes, on any pony/horse and can be led.

DECLARATION OF INDEMNITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISK **WEARING OF PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR**

The human head is very vulnerable and may suffer considerable damage owing to injuries caused by a fall or impact from a horse. Injuries to the head may have long term effects and in some cases can be life threatening. It has been proven that wearing a correctly fitted, good condition riding hat can protect the wearer from injury or reduce the overall effect of any impact or injury. Oakridge Arena, Sherwood Show Circuit & Oakridge Quarter Horses promote safe riding and competition and in order to further this aim strongly recommends that protective headgear to approved standards is worn while handling exercising riding or competing any horse or pony.

DECLARATION

I am aware of the risks involved in riding or competing without a solid and unbroken properly fitted BSI-approved riding hat or helmet bearing the CE mark and certified to BSEN1384/ BS PASO15 or ASTM-F1163/SEI or above and with the straps properly adjusted and fastened. I understand that Oakridge Arena, Sherwood Circuit & Oakridge Quarter Horses permit competitors without protective headgear to handle exercise ride or compete horses at their own risk subject to submission of the relevant disclaimer below.

As an adult aged 16 years or over, or responsible adult in charge of a child under 16yrs I hereby confirm that I accept full responsibility for not wearing protective headgear to the standards specified above while attending events. Having taken this decision I hereby indemnify Sherwood Circuit against all losses including but not limited to loss of income and all types of indirect or consequential loss that may be suffered or liability which may accrue to Sherwood Circuit, Oakridge arena or Oakridge Quarter Horses as a result of any injury suffered by myself or minor as a result of not wearing appropriate safety headgear while handling exercising riding or competing.
